#### Catholic Student Grant Program

The State K of C Educational Foundation is offering **Tuition Grants** to students in **Grades 1 through 12** enrolled in a Catholic School. To be eligible, the student must be the son or daughter of a Knight (or of a deceased Knight) in good standing.
